Childcare Worker 101 Course – Back to Basics

The learning areas covered in the course include: Responsibilities of a Childcare Worker, Safety in Classroom and Playground, Hygiene, Observation and Reporting, Caring for Babies, Assisting with the Classroom Program, Milestones per Age Group, Discipline in the Classroom and Playground Supervision etc. This course is a practical refresher course assisting Childcare Workers to go “back to basics”. It concentrates on the regulations of the Children’s Act. It also has a strong motivational input.

Childcare Worker 202 Course – Positive Discipline

Understanding toddler behaviour / origin, Reasons children misbehave, Learning to listen to behaviour, Understanding child development, Developmental stages, Protecting & preserving children’s feelings, Offering children choices, Changing the environment to shape behaviour. What is positive discipline? Guiding children to discipline, Teaching children positive discipline, The techniques of positive discipline, Tools to guide & discipline children.

Childcare Worker 303 Course – Classroom Management

This course is all about classroom setup, colour of walls, formal, informal and free choice learning areas. Our aim is to empower teachers and assistants to affect a productive learning environment. The importance of managing your classroom, so that effective learning can take place. How to manage behaviour challenges in the classroom with the least disruption to your other children in the class. Interventions that may be used to address aggression, anger, bullying, biting etc.

Childcare Worker 404 Course – Play and Development

Children learn through play. They instinctively side into play mode without thinking! This is a “how to” course for Nursery School teachers and assistants that will give them the tools to effect good learning by playing. As we move through the age groups, the what, when, where and how we use play as a learning tool will be fully discussed. Toys and play objects are shown to contribute to the development of language, imagination and intellectual achievement and to be effective in a child’s physical and emotional wellness. You will be trained to function within the field of age appropriate developmental skills putting your class and school a cut above the rest! We will teach you to develop games as well as to make equipment that can be used to affect learning. Be ready to absorb the many tips and suggestions that you can use in your class immediately!

Childcare Worker 505 Course – Childcare Safety

Developing and managing a safe school:

This course should be attended by ALL staff. We often hear of or experience children that are injured at Nursery Schools. There are even some children who die (very few) because of injury, choking or some circumstance at Nursery Schools. We must be aware and constantly apply our minds as to the safety of our classroom, our children and the school. If something happens we must feel that it was truly an accident and not that someone was negligent.
