ON THE MATTER OF DSD BEING ABLE TO APPEAL

The Minister is entitled to apply for leave to appeal against the order. The judge may or may not grant leave for an appeal.

If he does not, the order will stand unless overturned by the Supreme Court Appeal (this will require special permission from the SCA). If permission for an appeal is granted, it will suspend the order, unless the Court issues a directive that the order will stand pending the appeal. The applicants (us) will apply for such directive should the Minister apply for leave to appeal.

What this means in in layman's terms is:

The court granted all ECD's to open, so you open your school and start with operations while adhering to Covid-19 safety protocols. If DSD wants to appeal, our legal representation will ask the court for schools to stay open while the appeal is being heard. So, therefore you do not have to fear school closures.
